Official Transcripts (printed or Etranscripts* can be obtained in one of three ways:

- On Demand – Requires that you come into the office and provide a form of photo identification. In addition to the transcript fee (\$3.00 per copy; first two copies are free), you will be charged a \$7.00 per copy rush fee to take your transcript with you. Please be aware that some institutions consider hand carried transcripts unofficial. Please check with your receiving institution before you request official transcripts to take with you.
- By mail – You may send us a letter, or go to our website and download a copy of the Transcript Request form. You must provide us with your name, name used at the time of attendance, date of birth, student I.D. number, approximate dates of attendance, and the complete address where you would like us to send your transcript. Please clearly indicate any attachments that must be included with your transcript. You must check to be sure that you do not have holds that prevent the release of official transcripts. All financial holds must be cleared before we can process your transcript request. Be sure to contact Admissions to confirm that you are entitled to your two free transcripts, and if not, you must include payment of \$3.00 for each copy. Your processed request will be placed in the mail within 3 – 5 business days upon receipt of your request. You are responsible for submitting your order in time to meet any deadlines. All transcripts are mailed first class mail through the U.S. postal system.
- Online – Log into the Student Information System. Once logged in, go to the main menu and scroll down to the middle of the page. You will see the option to request transcripts and enrollment verifications online through the National Student Clearinghouse. You may not obtain your two free copies using this service. You must pay \$3.00 per transcript, plus an additional \$2.55 per copy convenience fee. You will be notified via email when your request has been processed at which time your credit card will be charged.
