Application Process

1. Complete application
2. Include unofficial transcript showing a minimum GPA of 3.0
3. Submit an essay of no more than 500 words (typed, double spaced) using one of the following prompts:

Prompt 1: Interview one or more persons who are members of a labor union about their views on how their union has helped them. Then, apply what you have learned to your own life and plans for your future.

Prompt 2: In the wake of attacks on undocumented students and others, discuss your views on the need and effects of the Los Angeles College Faculty Guild's decision to declare that LACCD colleges should be safe places for the continuation of the education of all our students, and in particular for our undocumented students and other targeted populations.

Prompt #3: For the last five years, your friend has been a part-time cook/server at a fast food restaurant. At work, local organizers are trying to persuade her to join their effort to unionize fast food restaurants such as the one where she works; however, while she very strongly agrees with the objective of the organizers, she fears losing her job. What would you advise her to do and why?

Minimum Qualifications

1. At least 12 units completed at a Los Angeles Community College
2. A minimum GPA of 3.0 for courses taken in the Los Angeles Community College District
3. Currently attending a college in the Los Angeles Community College District as a student carrying at least 9 units per semester
